Not a Fez to be Found

The latest and perhaps splashiest development downtown is the refurbished Moolah Temple. Now known as Moolah Temple/Lindell Towers, the building at 3821 Lindell has undergone a face-lift costing a cool \$40 million. Not only are there 42 loft apartments (the displays were decorated by The Lawrence Group Colors and furnished with items from Niche), but you needn't get the car out of the garage to be entertained. The building also houses a new eight-lane bowling alley (with pool table, digital jukebox, bar and grill), single-screen movie theater (with enough room for 400 seated on leather couches and chairs) and a bar.
